It is most suited to students aligned with the A-D curriculum, however some students with ASD /ID / Down Syndrome, working on F-10 Curriculum, may find the cause and effect games and songs very engaging/ soothing. The software is split into five sections: Early Years, Games and Quizzes, Stories and Songs, Creative Play & Find Out About. You will get the most out of these activities if an adult plays them with the child. Although there is a cost involved, it is a good investment for students with high support needs. Teachers can very easily create brief online videos and screenshares to provide instructions to isolated students from within the platform or attach video content created using other digital tools - e.g. flipped classroom content.
