Bless all those in countries not as safe as Australia right now. Amen











Dear Parent / Guardian,

The Martin Vale Dentistry's mobile van will be conducting dental visits at your school. Treatment may be BULK BILLED through Medicare Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) for eligible students. Students that are not eligible for CDBS funding have the option to receive treatment as a private patient.



CHILD DENTAL BENEFITS SCHEDULE **BULK BILLING PATIENT FORM**

I, the patient / legal guardian, certify that I have been informed:

I understand that benefits for some services may have restrictions and that Child Dental Benefits Schedule covers a limited range of services. I understand I will need to personally meet the costs of any services not covered by the Child Dental Benefits Schedule.

I understand that the cost of services will reduce the available benefit cap and that I will need to personally meet the costs of any additional services once benefits are exhausted.
