Illness

If your child has gastro, they need to stay home for 24 hours AFTER their last vomit or diarrhea. We know it is difficult when a child has been home for a few days, and they are improving, and really want to return. However, sending children to school when they are not quite right simply spreads viruses to others. We will continue to have children wash their hands with soap (for 20 seconds) and use hand sanitiser when they are at school to help stop the spread of illness. We will also continue to send children home if they are unwell.
