### **The Scriptures**

A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to Luke 15:1-10

Now all the tax-collectors and sinners were coming near to listen to him. And the Pharisees and the scribes were grumbling and saying, 'This fellow welcomes sinners and eats with them.' So he told them this parable: 'Which one of you, having a hundred sheep and losing one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness and go after the one that is lost until he finds it? When he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders and rejoices. And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbours, saying to them, "Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost." Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninetynine righteous people who need no repentance. 'Or what woman having ten silver coins, if she loses one of them, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it? When she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbours, saying, "Rejoice with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost." Just so, I tell you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.'

#### WHAT IS THE SEASON OF CREATION?


The Season of Creation is a time where Christian communities pray and reflect on how people can better care for creation and be closer to God our Creator.

#### WHEN IS THE SEASON OF CREATION?

The Season of Creation begins on the 1st of September and finishes with the feast of Saint Francis of Assisi on the 4th of October.

### WHY DO WE HAVE THE SEASON OF CREATION?

The Season of Creation Is an annual celebration of prayer and action to protect our common home. Creation is a precious gift from God that needs to be protected and cared for by and for the sake of everyone.



### HOW CAN WE GET INVOLVED IN THE SEASON OF CREATION?

We can get involved in the Season of Creation celebrations by:

- Praying- regularly for creation, ecological conversion and God as Creator;
- Reflecting on caring for creation- participate in an online Laudato Si' study group or Global Catholic

- Reducing our ecological footprint- explore ways the community can transition away from fossil fuels, considering meat free Fridays and




