Something to Think About

What do I need to pray for? How can I always be in communion with God? How can I engage in prayer more often?

The Story

Jesus is like a good friend here. He wants to keep us with him, just as none of us want to lose a friend. Friendship with Jesus is being with him, and being sent in his name. Our mission as his followers is in the midst of and in the depths of the world. He wants his love and message inserted in the centre of the world, the city, the neighbourhood. The Scriptures - John 17:11-19
