- Try to bake or make your own condiments instead of buying them at the shops
- Buy fair trade products, second hand or even re-gift to help and shop locally

- Reuse wrapping paper (for gifts or crafts) and you could even wrap gifts in clothes or material to reduce waste
- Hand-make cards or reuse old cards to reduce waste and save you money
- DIY gifts using your creativity and even recycled objects!


#### BREAD TAGS AND BOTTLE LIDS- WEDNESDAY 11th IS THE LAST DAY TO DONATE!!
