LET'S GO ON SAFARI

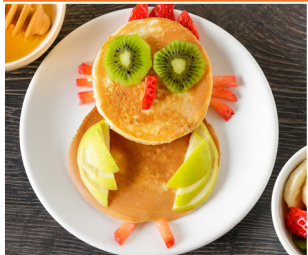
Thur 2 July

WOODWORK WORKSHOP

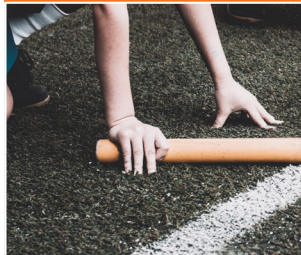
Thur 9 July
